



# **MARINE CORPS LEAGUE DETACHMENT 260 EAGLE SCOUT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

## **Procedures**

The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must:

- Complete the Application Personally
- Enclose only the items requested in the requirements
- Answer all questions on the application
- Include on each attachment the applicant name and address
- Submit all attachments with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time.
- The Marine Corps League Detachment 260 cannot assume responsibility for matching items that are submitted separately.
- Send completed application to Marine Corps League Det 260, PO Box 10227, Greensboro NC 27404. The Marine Corps League Detachment 260 is not responsible for lost or misdirected applications.
- There are no provisions for the Marine Corps League Detachment 260 to receive a Fax Version or an Email Version of the application.
- Be advised that only those applications postmarked on or before \_\_\_\_\_ will be considered.
- Be advised that applications become the property of the Selection Committee and will not be returned to the applicant.
- The committee will notify the recipient and all applicants when a decision has been made in writing. There are no appeals and the decision is final.
- Understand that submitting an application is in no way a guarantee that a scholarship will be granted.
- All applications may be printed or typed, please be legible.

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## **Requirements**

An Applicant must:

- Be an Active member of the Boy Scouts of America with an Eagle Scout Rank.
  - Have a Grade Point Average of 3.0 or Higher, and provide a written transcript of high school grades covering a minimum of six (6) semesters. (The transcript need not be "official" and may be a photocopy).
  - Have received a "Good Citizenship Award" from the Marine Corps League Detachment 260 prior to applying in order to qualify.
  - Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
  - Provide one (1) signed Letter of Recommendation from a Volunteer or Professional or Scout Leader who knows the applicant personally. Family members are excluded. Person providing letter of recommendation to provide their title and association to the Scout. **This is the only endorsement required. No other Endorsements will be entertained/considered.**
