Procedures

The Gold Award Scout applying for a scholarship must:

- Complete the Application personally.
- Enclose only the items requested in the requirements.
- Answer all questions on the application.
- Include your name and address on all attachments
- Submit all attachments with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time.
- The Marine Corps League Detachment 260 cannot assume responsibility for items that are submitted separately.
- **Send completed application to Marine Corps League Det 260, PO Box 10227, Greensboro NC 27404.** The Marine Corps League Detachment 260 is not responsible for lost or misdirected applications.
- All applications may be printed or typed.
- Be advised that only those applications postmarked on or before May 15th will be considered.
- There are no provisions for the Marine Corps League Detachment 260 to receive Fax or Email Versions of the application
- Be advised that applications become the property of the Selection Committee and none will not be returned to the applicants.
- The MCL-260 Scholarship Committee will notify the scholarship recipient(s) and all other applicants via email or phone call. There are no appeals and the decision of the Committee is final.
- Understand that submitting an application is in no way a guarantee that a scholarship will be granted.

Requirements

An Applicant must:

- Be an active member of the Girl Scouts of America with an Gold Award Scout Rank and a graduating High School Senior by June 2019.
 - Have a Grade Point Average of 3.0 or Higher, and provide a written transcript of high school grades covering a minimum of six (6) semesters. (The transcript need not be “official” and may be a photocopy).
 - Have received a “Good Citizenship Award” from the Marine Corps League Detachment 260 prior to applying in order to qualify.
 - Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
 - Provide one (1) signed Letter of Recommendation from a Scout Leader, Teacher/Principal or other person who knows the applicant personally. Person providing letter of recommendation to include his/her title and association to the Scout. Family members are excluded. **This is the only endorsement required. No other Endorsements will be entertained/considered.**
